



## 2010 Farmington Art in the Park

### *Invitation to participate*

**Date:** Friday, July 30, in conjunction with Farmington Summer Fest

**Time:** Set up between 8:30 – 11am. Show hours 11am – 6pm. You must be set up fully by 11am, and remain until 6 pm as advertised. Many say sales are best in the last hours before closing.

**Spaces:** We will assign spaces, though you may state your preference. The shrubs grow each year in the park, and there are additions of stationary objects (monuments, benches), but we will try to fit each preference.

**Artwork:** **Fine art:** paintings, prints, drawings, photography, mixed media and collage, fabric hangings.

**Fine art craft:** Sculpture, jewelry, pottery (...no crocheted bleach containers, no potholders, no foreign made) All entries for Purchase Prizes must be original work, conceived and created by the entrant. 2-D work must be framed or outfitted for wall hanging. Each entrant is responsible for his or her own work and sales. Photographs must be entirely original.

**People's Choice Award:** Selected from all works in the show by attendees of Farmington Art in the Park. Ballots will be available for voting from main table during the day, votes to be tallied and prize awarded at 4pm. Artist with most votes will win a community prize of goods and/or services worth up to \$100.

**Purchase Prizes:** Each artist and photographer may designate up to 3 original works for purchase prizes, with a value of \$250.each. Purchase Prize buyers will have first opportunity to choose from the designated pieces between 11am – 1pm. Designated works may not be sold to the general public until the purchase prizes have been completed. Artisans may satisfy the purchase prizes with undesignated pieces at you and your buyer's mutual agreement.

**Displays:** Exhibitors shall provide their own stands, and be prepared in event of rain shower to cover belongings with a tarp or other raingear. Spaces are 10x10', approximately. Forecasted heavy rain will enact the rain plan for an indoor location tba.

**Entry Fee:** \$35. Per artist must accompany registration form. Artists sharing a space must register with said fee each. No refunds will be given after July 15.

**Advertising:** This year the Farmington Downtown Association will cover our event in all their advertising. It is important for artists to also promote the event.
